1	A (j)	The first letter of the English and of many other alphabets. The capital A of the alphabets of Middle and Western Europe, as also of

19	A- (j)	A, as a prefix to English words, is derived from various sources. (j) It frequently signifies <i>on</i> or <i>in</i> (from <i>an</i> , a form of <i>AN</i> , <i>on</i>), <i>der</i>

21	A 1 (j)	A registry mark given by underwriters (as at Lloyd's) to ships in first-class condition. Inferior grades are indicated by A 2 and A 3.

I got the word meanings from [OPTED\(The Online Plain Text English Dictionary\)](#), which is based on "*The Project Gutenberg Etext of Webster's Unabridged Dictionary*" which is in turn based on the 1913 US Webster's Unabridged Dictionary (See [Project Gutenberg](#)), as a *text file*.

I then converted the text files into csv. I am sharing those here if anyone needs them.
